GUIDELINES FOR CHOOSING SUBJECTS

Art, Craft & Design

This is a very broad based subject which includes observational drawing, painting, printmaking, basic photography, graphic design and display, and three-dimensional work, e.g. modelling, carving, construction. You will learn to use a variety of materials, media, tools and equipment, and to understand art and design elements. Imagination, creativity, and interest in art, craft and design are good indicators of success in this subject.

Business Studies

The management of personal finance, an appreciation of economic realities and enterprise, and the role of information technology are the major themes of this subject. Your present performance in English and Mathematics will give some indication of how successfully you can take up this subject.

Technical Graphics

Straight lines, angles, scales, plane figures and solid geometry are key items in this subject. Skills in the use of drawing instruments, exactness in thought and action, developing powers of perception and of constructive imagination are part of the learning process. Neatness and accuracy in drawing, will indicate to you how well you can get on in this subject which is important for Engineering and Architecture.

Metalwork

This subject is an introduction to materials and process engineering. The Techniques and Design section involves learning to use tools, processes and the design and function of simple engineering components. The Materials and Technology section examines the properties of tools and materials and their applications. An interest and ability in constructing things are good indicators of success in this subject.

Materials Technology (Woodwork)

Practical work, theory and drawing are the major parts of Materials Technology (Wood). You will learn to use tools and materials, to make simple projects, to interpret drawings, and to make judgements about tools and materials. An interest and ability in constructing things are good indicators of success in this subject.
